In 2018, Bailey Place Insurance celebrates its 160th year of business in downtown Cortland!

"One hundred and sixty years is an exceptional accomplishment in this industry," Bailey Place President Steve Franco said. "It is a tribute to the hard work of everyone who has been a part of the business over the years and to the loyalty of our clients. The Central New York community knows they can trust and rely on the agents at Bailey Place to provide the insurance they need and the service they deserve."

In 1858, as Cortland County was celebrating its 50th anniversary, the roots of what would become Bailey Place Insurance were planted in downtown Cortland. The company is proud to have maintained its commitment to the community and the downtown area 160 years later.

First owned by Charles Foster, a Main Street attorney in Cortland, and then by Charles F. Brown, a prominent local businessman, the foundation

for what would become Bailey Place Insurance was established. Mr. Brown, who was Jim Place's great-grandfather, and the Place family ran the agency from 1911 until 2010. Place Insurance was housed at several prominent Main Street locations during the 20th century. In 1986, Jim Place purchased the site of the former Hotel Cortland and constructed the building that houses the agency today. For the next 30 years, Place Insurance could be found under the "blue roof."









In 2010, Steve Franco purchased the building and Place Insurance. Three years later, in 2013, Franco merged Place Insurance with the George B. Bailey Agency, creating what is now known as Bailey Place Insurance. The Bailey Agency also has a long and storied history, serving the Dryden and Tompkins County area for more than 80 years. The Place and Bailey merger allowed for expansion, as Bailey Place now has three convenient offices in Cortland, Dryden and Ithaca, employing 25 people. In December of 2015, Bailey Place acquired the Cotterill Agency, another local business with a proud history in the Dryden community.













Historically, the location of the Cortland office has been known by locals as the "blue roof building." Then in 2017, Bailey Place Insurance invested again in its future by replacing the roof and making other façade improvements using exclusively local contractors. The improvements replaced the blue roof with a shingled roof. Upgrades were also made to the columns, signage, landscaping, sidewalks, and masonry. While the building looks new, it now has some historical design elements, including several ornate bricks from the Hotel Cortland inlaid in the columns.

Regardless of the location of the offices, throughout all 160 years of its history, and as it looks to the future, Bailey Place Insurance is proud to be owned locally, providing jobs to local residents and protection to local customers.













Bailey Place Insurance has been named the 2018 Giving Network Agency of the Year for outstanding community service.
